## Instructions to heirs of deceased site owners who wish to transfer their inherited sites

- 1. As a matter of due diligence, the staff of Fairfax Memorial Park must:
  - a. Verify if the Owner(s) of Record are buried here. If not, death certificate(s) for the deceased lot owners must be produced by heirs.
  - b. Verify whether deceased lot owner(s) will(s) specifically designates the new owner of the burial spaces. (e.g., "I bequeath my unused burial spaces at Fairfax Memorial Park to\_\_\_\_\_.")
  - c. Verify whether the "alleged" heir(s) are the only heir(s).
  - d. Obtain the old Certificate of Ownership.
- 2. Use "Ownership Certification for Heirs" form below and attach to transfer form with required documentation.
  - a. To facilitate the transfer, the heir(s) must, as needed, produce death certificate(s), copy of Will(s), and sign an indemnity statement certifying that they are the only heir(s).
- 3. Upon proof satisfactory to the cemetery of the authority of the transferor, a new Certificate of Ownership will be issued to the new owners to whom the sites are being sold.

Note: Ordinarily, the Cemetery does not issue a new Certificate of Ownership upon the death of a lot owner; but, instead, does so upon a subsequent sale or other transfer of the site(s).

## Ownership Certification for Heirs

(This form is to be used in conjunction with FMP's "Site Transfer Form".)

To assist in establishing proper and complete ownership, please answer the following questions:
