

## Flower Regulations

- 1. All decorative/floral objects are cleared from all graves, mausoleums, columbaria, and personal crypts two times per year: March 1<sup>st</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> and November 15<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup>. Please retrieve objects with sentimental value prior to these dates.
- 2. Only one decorative/floral object may be placed on a grave at a time. Flowers must be in approved vase. Holiday decorations and wreaths/sprays on easels will be permitted between November 21<sup>st</sup> and January 31<sup>st</sup>. All holiday decorations will be promptly removed by cemetery staff after January 31st. Wreaths/sprays on easels must be anchored securely to the ground, away from all bronze memorials. Wind chimes are permitted only if hung on tree branches and have sounding elements that are less than six (6) inches in length.
- 3. Artificial flowers are permitted, but may be removed at our discretion when they become weathered, damaged, or are damaging the bronze memorial.
- 4. Flowers should be securely anchored in the vase. If flowers are blown away, we are not responsible to return them to the correct grave or to provide compensation for their loss.
- 5. Graves are cleared of wilted or weathered objects throughout the year as deemed necessary by the Groundskeepers. If you wish to retrieve a live plant, do so before the plant wilts and is removed. We are not responsible for flowers and plants left on graves.
- 6. Mausoleum and Columbarium floral tributes are to be placed only in areas designated by the Cemetery.
- 7. Groundskeepers reserve the right to reposition or remove objects that either do not conform to the Cemetery Rules and Regulations or interfere with performance of maintenance activities.
- 8. No planting, except in areas designated by the Cemetery.
- 9. No glass containers, tin cans, or baskets.
- 10. No miscellaneous objects (pinwheels, balloons, large flags, etc.)
- 11.Decorations not in compliance with these regulations will be removed.
